

Hotel Reservations

The Symposium will be held at the **Hotel President Wilson** a 5-star luxury hotel that is away from the crowd, but still in the "heart of the city." Located on the waterfront promenade offering spectacular views of Lake Geneva, Mont Blanc and the Alps, it is steps away from international organizations, shopping, restaurants and entertainment. The hotel is a 20-minute ride from Geneva International Airport and a 15-minute walk from the train station.

A block of rooms have been reserved for Symposium attendees at 400 CHF per night for single/double inclusive of breakfast and VAT.

During the weekend of the Symposium, Geneva will be hosting an annual sailing competition on the Lake, a national event attended by sailing enthusiasts from all over Europe. Hotel rooms will be scarce and at a premium, so reserve your room immediately. The ICA group rate is heavily discounted but the block is limited and will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. About Geneva

Geneva is the second largest city in Switzerland and the most international city in Europe with over 40% of its population coming from outside Switzerland. Geneva prides itself as being one of the most beautiful and cultured cities in the world combining the splendors of nature with a rich palette of historic and architectural offerings. The city is



also the major gateway to the world famous Alps for outdoor enthusiasts year round.

The city is easily reached within 2 hours by plane from most major cities in Europe and is a hub of Europe's highway network. High speed train connections to Paris and Milan, as well as fast trains to Spain and Germany provide additional access.

Currency: The currency is the Swiss Franc (CHF, SFr.). Euros are accepted at most businesses but expect to pay a premium rate. Most transactions in the city are conducted in cash and a surprising number of businesses and



restaurants do not accept credit cards so be prepared. ATMs are widely available throughout the city.

Climate: Due to the tempering effects of the lake and surrounding mountains, Geneva is pleasant almost year round. June is a beautiful time of the year with warm temperatures, relatively low humidity and cool breezes from the lake.

Sightseeing: Geneva is the perfect base for exploring the surrounding countryside. It's

most famous monument, the Jet d'eau, the world's tallest water fountain is within view of the conference hotel. You can stroll down the promenade, take a day or evening cruise, walk to shopping or take a launch to Old Town on the other side of the lake. Mini-trains are a great way to see the city as well. You can contact the concierge at the President Wilson for more information about different tours available.



Tour/dinner at the Olympic Museum

Friday evening enjoy a special tour with dinner at the Olympic Museum in Lausanne near the International Olympic Committee's international headquarters. The current museum, which grew out of a collection dating back to 1915 has more than 87,000 objects in a modern, well-equipped building. The exhibits span a range of more than 2,200 years, starting with the ancient Greek games and continuing with the modern Olympic Games from 1896 to the present day. Also worth a stroll are the attractive landscaped grounds with sculptures, fountains and pavilions that range from the whimsical to Andre Ricard's The Cauldron, with its eternal Olympic flame.
