ICA Calls on All DCs to Give Back to Returning Veterans with Free Chiropractic Care

"ICA Cares" makes available specially designed poster for volunteers DCs

The ICA is calling on all DCs to give back to their fellow citizens in the armed forces returning home from Iran or Afghanistan with free chiropractic care. To help volunteer doctors show support of our armed forces and their offer of free chiropractic care, ICA has designed a poster that can be customized with the doctor's name and phone number.

It was in 2008 that ICA Board Member Dr. RJ Kelly initiated a volunteer program called "ICA Cares" for chiropractors to provide free care for one year to veterans returning from Iraq and Afghanistan. In an appeal to his colleagues Dr. Kelly wrote: "Whether visibly wounded or free of outward symptoms, they [our veterans] are coming home changed. I believe as chiropractors we can do much more than wave a flag or buy breakfast for a uniformed man and woman. I believe that through the power of the chiropractic adjustment we can help them restore their lives physically, mentally, emotionally and spiritually."

Approximately 300+ DCs have signed up for this program, but with more troops scheduled to return home in the near future, more volunteers are needed to provide chiropractic care to these brave men and women. ICA urges doctors in all states to join the "ICA Cares" program. It is the least chiropractic can do to give back to those who have put their lives on the line so others can enjoy the freedom they do. You do not have to be an ICA member to join the program, but you do have to have a license to practice.

To help promote this free service, ICA has designed a poster that can be customized with the doctor's name, phone number and the city of his/her practice. The poster was designed by an advertising agency whose owner, a chiropractic patient, wanted to show her support of our nation's troops and chiropractic by volunteering their professional design services on a complimentary basis.

To make it easy for doctors to print as many posters as they want, a link has been set up with a printer on ICA's website www.icapediatrics.com. Volunteer DCs can contact the printer directly through this link without having to go through ICA and order posters of any size and quantity customized with their name and telephone number.
