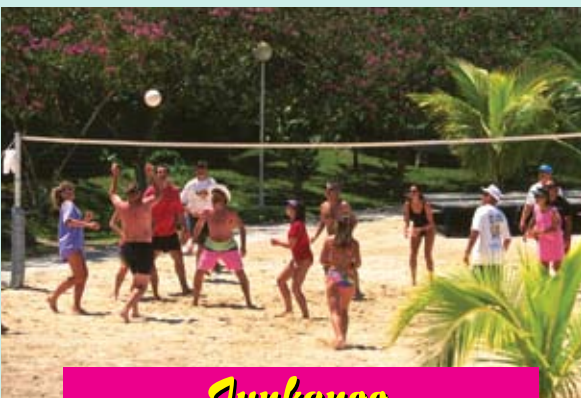

The Westin is the more upscale hotel, and the Sheraton is a low-rise property close to the family pools and Kids Camp, an activity center that offers baby sitting for kids 3-12. There are plenty of restaurants on the resort and one can also walk across the street to the Lucaya marketplace that has numerous restaurants, eateries, shops and entertainment. There is also a Casino on property, situated in a separate building between the two hotels and



a spa and fitness center in the Westin side of the property. There are plenty of water activities including scuba lessons, jet skiing, parasailing, snorkeling, kayaking and banana boating. Call the concierge of the hotel you are staying at in advance so you can make arrangements before your arrival. Also ask about other off site excursions especially the encounter with Dolphins, horse riding on the beach, exploring the coves, etc. It is recommended you reserve these activities in advance as they fill up quickly.

Airport

The airport you fly into is FREEPORT in the Grand Bahama Island. There are direct flights from most of the major cities in the US or with just one connection. If you connect at Nassau it is a short flight of 45 minutes and if you connect at one of the Florida cities it is also a short flight to the Bahamas.

Ground Transportation: The hotel does not have a shuttle and if you are not renting a car, a taxi is your best means of transportation from the airport. It is a 20-minute ride.
