Federal Stafford loan default rate is zero at Northwestern

The students who take out loans to pay for their education at Northwestern are obviously paying it back. According to information released by the federal government, the default rate of students from NWHSU is zero. The cohort default rate is calculated by the federal government each year to evaluate how effective schools are at administering loans. Restrictions are put on schools that receive a high cohort default rate.

"Educational loan debt is good debt. It is an investment for a student who will have a career and higher earnings," said Mr. Andrew Hoppin, Northwestern's director of financial aid. "The low default rate, zero in this case, means students are being responsible and repaying their loans. This is a great reflection of the students, the institution and the use of federal government resources."

Integrity Management donates \$500,000 to college's capital campaign
