The ICA Diplomate in Chiropractic Pediatrics is currently offered only through Palmer College. Palmer College will start Year I in the Spring in Chicago. Doctors interested in pediatrics postgraduate education but do not want to commit to the 3-year Diplomate program, can opt to get a Certificate in Chiropractic Pediatrics (CCP) from the ICA Council on Chiropractic Pediatrics after completing Year I.
