Master's degree in Sports Science offered under Logan University name

The Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association has approved Logan's plan to offer a master of

science degree in sports science and rehabilitation. The degree will be offered under the Logan University name.

This new master's degree program will be open to both students admitted



to the DC program who wish to earn a concurrent MS degree, and to students who have already earned a bachelor's degree. Practicing DCs can also enroll in the program.

The master's program in sports science is designed to offer a specialized advanced degree option for sports injury management. It requires 50 hours of course work including classroom, lab and clinical experience taken over a five-semester period (approximately 20 months). The program, according to Patrick M. Browne, EdD, vice president of academic affairs, will afford students numerous opportunities to participate in multidisciplinary clinical settings with professional collegiate and high school sports teams. In addition, the BIOFREEZE Sports and Rehabilitation Center located on campus, specially designed to treat athletic injuries, will provide students with the opportunity to work with athletes in a therapeutic environment.

As Logan expands the range of degree offerings, the college will utilize the official nomenclature of "Logan University" for all master's level programs. "The name 'Logan College of Chiropractic' will continue to be used in all documents, publications and public communications related to chiropractic, affirming through its use the proud distinction of the doctor of chiropractic degree as our principle educational purpose," said Dr. George Goodman, Logan College president. "However, it is now appropriate for us to use the wider university identity to include not only our study of chiropractic, but also that of our bachelor of science degrees in human biology and life science, and the newly authorized master's degree. Use of the Logan University name and development of our first master's degree program enables us to help students prepare for specialized career opportunities in today's health care world," he said.
